NEW GIFTING GUIDELINES

Gifting Guiding Principles

- The Friends use guiding principles when determining how their financial resources will be utilized to support the Dunlap Public Library. Such principles are important to:
 - Insure a level of consistency
 - Maintain status as a non-profit organization
 - Develop shared understanding between all members that may participate in this process (e.g., Friends members, Friends board members, Library staff, etc.)
- These principles are meant to be used as a guide and the document may be modified via vote as needed.

Selecting and Prioritizing Library Gifts

- Non-Profit Compliance
 - Ensure gifts don't jeopardize the Friends' non-profit status.
- Mission Alignment
 - Gifts must align with the Friends' Mission and Vision.
- Patron Benefit
 - Prioritize gifts benefiting a significant number of patrons.
- Financial Sustainability
 - Consider ongoing expenses and Friends' funding ability.
- Library Approval
 - Vet gifts to ensure utility and maintenance feasibility.
- Community Exposure
 - Gifts should enhance Friends' visibility and support.
- Durability
 - Opt for durable items due to high public usage.
- Historical Funding
 - Avoid gifts the Library has traditionally funded to prioritize new opportunities.


